THY KINGDOM COME

Thy Kingdom Come is a global prayer movement that invites Christians around the world to pray from Ascension to Pentecost for more people to come to know Jesus. Since its start in May 2016, as an invitation from the Archbishops of Canterbury and York to the Church of England, it has now grown into an international and ecumenical call to prayerCome Holy Spirit.

During the 9 days of 'Thy Kingdom Come ' it is hoped that everyone who takes part will:

- Pray for others to come to faith in Jesus
- Pray for the empowerment of the Spirit that we would be effective in our witness.
